2 Trustee Board Vacancies (3-year term of office)

Here is an exciting opportunity to input your ideas and use your experience to influence the strategic direction and governance of a significant local foodbank in your postcode.

During 2021, three trustees resigned at the end of their three-year terms of office. We still have two vacancies. Trustees are appointed by the Trustee Board. Being a trustee is a voluntary role.

Overall Purpose: The Trustee Board is responsible for the overall governance and strategic direction of our Charitable Incorporated Organisation, monitoring and developing the organisation's aims, objectives and goals in accordance with our governing document, legal guidelines and regulatory guidelines.

Time Commitment: The Trustee Board currently meets 4 times per year (January, April, June, October), usually in the evenings for about 2 ½ hours. There is also an Annual General Meeting. Additional meetings are occasionally required. If work / family commitments allow, a trustee is linked with one of our venues so he/she can visit, see the foodbank in action and build relationships with one of our volunteer teams.
