Ukraine & Yemen

The situations in both Ukraine and Yemen continue to be disastrous. The escalating war in Yemen, with ports blocked and the resultant huge rise in prices means millions of internally displaced refugees cannot get food or medicine. The plight of the little children is especially horrific as their resistance is low, and many are starving. Thank you to all who continue to support our attempts to send basic, vitally needed aid. We intend to send our 8th 40 foot container at the end of August/beginning of September, giving us time to raise the necessary funding and receive the most urgent supplies.

The war in Ukraine is more immediately on our doorstep, and local people from eastern Europe are being very supportive of our efforts there. A group of businessmen take vans every few weeks and take whatever primary aid we have collected. The next shipment is due to go out on the 17th of this month, and we are sending bandages, dressings, food (veg soup powder, rice and tins of meat) wheelchairs, crutches, analgesics.
