# From St John Perry

Thanks for praying. Within hours of sending the last prayer letter there was movement on two fronts. First, news came from the Diocese of Rochester that

Bishop Jonathan was happy to move matters forward, and was asking his Chaplain to process the necessary *Permission to Officiate*. Out in Sabah this development of oversight by a UK bishop was greeted warmly, exactly what they were hoping for. Second, the ordination service was moved from Telupid in the remote Borneo interior, to All Saints Cathedral, Kota Kinabalu. This is sad in a way, but very much simplifies all the logistics.
