Bradford North Foodbank – Shipley

A huge thank you for all your donations which help us to be able to continue to feed people who need help and to signpost them to further support.

Did you know that people from St. Peter's donated 2,176 kg of food in the year to 31 March 2023? This makes food parcels for 103 families, providing 3,153 meals alongside other daily essentials. There is a certificate from the foodbank on display in the new porch.

At the moment we especially need: **tinned tomatoes, soup, hot chocolate, tuna, UHT Milk (whole milk and semi skimmed), UHT fruit juice (not from the chiller cabinet), chocolate or sweets, coffee (100g), sugar 1kg, pasta sauce, instant mash.**

Please also remember to save and donate empty **washing up liquid bottles**. Please continue to pray for the work of the foodbank, the people who come, the staff, and volunteers who give their time to support and listen to people in need. Thank you. Anthea, Julie, Pete, Stuart and Sue
