Wonderful.

And then today, I find myself over whelmed with joy, as I watched the lounge filled with nearly 70 older people dancing, singing songs and alive in the moment. I watched students from the college serving, washing up and eating cake and enjoying the sense of belonging and connection that was the event - Musical Memories.

So many thanks to the 15 or so volunteers and the multitude of bakers who made cakes and scones, giving up so much of their time to serve others - particularly to Karen Parkinson who carried so much of this event. It was fabulous.

This is such an amazing demonstration of generosity and kindness. It tells me how we are alive in Christ and alive to the desire to serve in our time and our money.
