# Practicing the Way: Prayer and Solitude

Mark 1: 32-39

# THIS WEEK'S REFLECTION

Spending time on our own can often feel daunting, selfish, lonely.

Jesus however shows us that this is something he regularly did. And what is particularly interesting is that he goes off on his own to pray when he is particularly busy! In our world, we might be tempted to say come on Jesus, don't slack now - get the job done and then take your time. But the point is, Jesus understands where he gets his strength from. He understands that he needs time with God to fill him up. He needs space to retreat from people and demands and distractions to intentionally be with God, in order to be able to give and help and bless.

A cup can only overflow if it is filled; similarly, we can only truly share God's love, grace and goodness with others if we first allow him to fill us. Paul tells the Ephesians to be filled with the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18), but the word he uses indicates that this is something we should be doing continually, rather than a one-off act: we must keep on being filled with the Spirit. If Jesus needed time alone with his Father in order to do his work, then how much more must we! Time alone with God needs to be our first port of call, not a last resort; it is the power source of our service, the place where we receive in order to give. Let us commit to spending time alone with God each day; to share our burdens with him and to receive his love, grace and blessing. But then let us also commit to going out into the world, renewed by His strength to share his love with our friends and neighbours.
