THIS WEEK'S REFLECTION

I am not sure why but Advent always seems to creep up on me! A time when the rest of the world is ramping up busyness that also requires us as Christians to find quiet, space to listen in our waiting for Christ's arrival. Advent is the time when we can focus our attention on what it means that our God came to this earth as a fragile human baby. That our creator God announced through an angel that His son would be born to a teenage unmarried girl and then be born at an unsafe time in an unsafe place. This fragility of God reflects so many lives and experiences.

This is the time when we remember the shocking absence of wealth, security, worldly status and power of our God. That everything about His arrival speaks about including people who would otherwise have expected to be left out of any grand king's arrival and birth.

The angels announce to the shepherds that now is the time for good news and joy for all the world. Emmanuel has come - God with us. Our hope in a life that can be changed for the better is re-lit. Light has come to conquer the darkness.

So we wait and get ready for Jesus' arrival. We count each Sunday down remembering the great patriarchs and matriarchs, the prophets and saints,

John the Baptist and Mary - each playing their part in being obedient to God. Each listening and following Him, risking themselves because they love and know God. As our Romans reading highlights "The night is nearly over;

salvation and bringing reconciliation to the world through Christ's transforming love.

Amen.

The approaching season of Advent calls us to be watchful as we wait for God's coming and God's kingdom. There are many situations in the world where we yearn for God's coming - hoping for the new dawn. But the times remain dark and difficult - we watch whilst wars destroy our world, where broken relationships between people shoot cruel unforgettable words and actions shatter hearts, where greed over rides the care for others. We as Christ's followers and apprentices are to seek and offer His light. Offering an alternative way to living life, because we have the hope of

the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armour of light". (Romans 13:12)

I pray that each of us, this year will find a way that we can spend more time with God, asking Him to show us new insights into God's almost incomprehensible act of love and generosity of allowing His son to come as a fragile baby to a life of uncertainty. That we will be shown how we too, can reflect His love and kindness to those around us, that in this Christmas time we find a time of new found joy in this love.
